

CHSU Student Scholarships

Up to \$25,000 in CHSU Scholarships Available for Incoming Class of 2026 Students!

Students enrolled in the incoming 2026 CHSU College of Biosciences and Health Professions Master of Science in Biomedical Sciences (MSBS) program may be eligible for a \$5,000 CHSU Scholarship to help reduce their educational expenses.

- Up to five (5) \$5,000 scholarships will be awarded.
- Students must complete the CHSU Scholarship application in its entirety by June 16, 2025.
- CHSU Scholarships are awarded on a first come, first served basis, so apply early to increase your chances of receiving an award!

Eligibility Requirements

- Have been offered, accepted their admission, and enrolled for the 2025-2026 academic year at the CHSU Master of Science in Biomedical Sciences (MSBS).
- Have a minimum GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.
- Meet eligibility for merit and/or need.

Scholarship awards are dispensed at 50% of the maximum amount per semester if the student maintains a 3.0 cumulative GPA and remains in good academic and professional standing each semester at CHSU.

For example, a student awarded a \$5,000 CHSU Scholarship and maintained eligibility each semester, would receive two, \$2,500 scholarship awards, one for each of the Fall 2025 and Spring 2026 semesters.
